

#### To the Waterford Place Residents:

J&J Trash Service, Inc., a family-owned and operated business located in Mt. Airy, Maryland, will provide solid waste collection and disposal services for the Waterford Place community beginning January 1, 2022.

### Service & Collection Guidelines

# Trash Service Days and Hours

- ➤ Monday and Thursday (between 7:00-10:00 AM)
- ➤ Please have your trash containers ready for pick up by 7:00 AM.
- > Household trash is collected twice weekly at the curbside. Any messes made during normal collection will be cleaned up.

# Holiday Schedule (collection will not take place on the following holidays)

- > J&J Trash Service, Inc. observes the following holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.
- In addition, service will not occur on any other day the Montgomery County landfill/transfer station is closed.
- If one of these holidays falls on a regular collection day, that day will be skipped until the next regularly scheduled collection day.

#### Containers

Residents should continue to provide their personal garbage/trash containers. J&J Trash Service, Inc. will collect and dispose of the bagged and sealed solid waste generated by the Waterford Place residents, and the sealed bags should be placed inside the trash containers and covered with protective, rodent-proof lids.

## Waste Material/Items Excluded from Regular Collection

- > The bagged waste material collected and disposed of by J&J is the trash/solid waste generated by the customer.
- > The following items <u>cannot be collected</u>: any radioactive, flammable, explosive, toxic, or hazardous materials, dead animals, dirt, rocks, sod, grass, tree branches, construction and remodeling materials, and parts of motor vehicles.
- This term hazardous materials shall include, but not be limited to, any amounts of waste listed or characterized as hazardous by the United States Environmental Protection Agency or any state agency pursuant to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976, as amended, and applicable to state law.

## Bulk Pick Up (J&J Trash Service, Inc.; extra charge to the homeowner will apply)

- Contact J&J Trash Service, Inc. to schedule pick up for bulk trash items. Call 301-898-2109 for FREE cost estimates.
- > Bulk items must be scheduled in advance, and there will be an extra charge to the homeowner due at the time of scheduling.
- > Bulk does not include yard waste, metal, appliances, or other items Montgomery County declares recyclable.

# Montgomery County Bulk Items Disposal - www.montgomerycountymd.gov/bulktrash

- ▶ Bring the bulk items to the <u>Shady Grove Processing Facility and Transfer Station or the Poolesville</u> <u>Beauty Spot</u>. Dispose of loads of trash under 500 pounds at no charge. The Transfer Station also accepts trash loads of 500 pounds or more see fee schedule.
- NOTE: Residents with private/subscription trash service via an individual or homeowners/community association contract are not eligible for Montgomery County bulk trash pick-up service. (Source: www.montgomerycountymd.gov/bulktrash)

### Montgomery County-Provided Recycling Collections and Service (Recycling and Yard Trim)

- Waterford Place receives recycling collection from Montgomery County. Service includes a once-a-week, curbside collection of recyclables.
- Monday (between 7:00-10:00 AM)
- ➤ Please place all recyclables and yard trim at the curb by 7:00 AM.
- Prepare yard trim as follows:
  - Place the material into large paper yard trim bags, available at most grocery stores, home improvement stores, and garden centers. Each paper bag must not exceed 45 pounds. Do not use paper grocery bags or plastic bags for yard trim collection.
  - Place the material into reusable containers, like trash cans. Containers must have a County "yard trim" label on them. Each container must not exceed 45 pounds.
  - Bundle your brush with twine. Each bundle must be 30 inches or less in diameter and weigh 45 pounds or less.
  - Prepare leaves in paper yard trim bags or reusable containers, not in plastic bags.
- ➤ How to recycle/dispose of yard trim (leaves, grass, and brush)

- All materials collected at the curb are also accepted daily at the Shady Grove Processing Facility and Transfer Station
- Adjustments to the collection schedule are made for nine holidays each year. The schedule is adjusted only if the actual (not the observed) holiday falls on a collection day.

### Scrap Metal Collections

- Properties receiving Montgomery County-provided recycling collection service are entitled to scrap metal collections. There is no annual limit on scrap metal requests.
- > Property residents must schedule large scrap collections in advance with the County, either by filling out the online form or by calling 311.
